EDUCATIONAL PATHWAYS


FAMILY OF PARISHES **NEW** LIVING FAITH

This new flexible approach is great for families who attend Mass regularly and want to engage in the life of their faith community. Most of the learning is done at home to prepare for upcoming events. Learners will attend events and briefly record their participation. The cycle of prepare, attend, and record, is repeated at least four times a month.

BEST FOR families that want formation that is flexible, and who are willing to make the commitment to be self-motivated.

OFFERED for grades 1-6. Events are offered at a wide variety of days and times. Attend worship, service, education, or fellowship events, while completing other work at home.

ST. ISIDORE TRADITIONAL CLASSROOM

This traditional format meets weekly in an interactive classroom setting. Youth follow a guided discussion with a textbook and activities. Faith is brought to life through Gospel Time, Family Nights and Mass.

BEST FOR students that enjoy learning in a classroom setting with their peers.

OFFERED for grades 1-6 on Monday or Tuesday evenings from 4:30-5:45 PM or 6:15-7:30 PM

ST. THERESE OF LISIEUX LEARNING STATIONS

In this format, children move from room to room to learn about Jesus, our Church, and the readings for the next weekend's Mass. Classes meet about every-other week. Special family events are included as well.

BEST FOR students that benefit from hands-on learning and more movement.

OFFERED for grades 1-6 on Monday or Tuesday evenings from 5:00-6:15 PM or 6:30-7:45 PM

ST. FRANCIS-ST. MAXIMILIAN TRADITIONAL SATURDAYS

Similar to St. Isidore's approach, this format follows a guided discussion. Sessions are in English only. However, materials are bilingual Spanish/English to help dual language families.

BEST FOR families with Spanish speaking parents, or those who want a Saturday option.

OFFERED for grades K-6 on Saturday mornings from 9:00-10:30 AM

AT YOUR HOME PARISH CONFIRMATION PREP

Each of our parishes (St. Therese, St. Isidore and St. Francis-St. Max) offers a two-year Confirmation preparation that is based on group meetings, and participation in other activities, such as service, retreats, and fellowship.

BEST FOR students in grades 7-9 who want to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation

OFFERED at St. Therese on Monday or Tuesday evenings from 5:00-6:15 PM or 6:30-7:45 PM

St. Isidore on Monday or Tuesday evenings from 4:30-5:45 PM or 6:15-7:30 PM

St. Francis-St. Maximilian every other Saturday from 3:00-5:00 PM



SACRAMENTS FOR CHILDREN

Regardless of where you do your formation:

If you have a child who is preparing for a sacrament, you'll participate in sacrament preparation and celebration in your Home Parish. Make sure to indicate which sacraments you are seeking as you register each child.
